## **High Hatton Hall**

The owners of the Grade II listed High Hatton Hall in the county of Shropshire, commissioned a refurbishment of the walled gardens and installation of a pool, pathways and entrance driveway. The small country house, built in 1762, has changed hands many times since the original landlord and was once owned by Christchurch College, Oxford as a root farm. The paths and drive of the small country house were laid with LeesonGrip, the product being chosen for its quality and decorative finish, adding to the experience for the visitor as they are led around the parklands and lawns.
